7) Anglers Utopia is a group of villas with associated fishing lakes. It has been designed for people with disabilities and one of the villas sleeps up eight with an entrance ramp, open plan lounge/kitchen with the controls useable from wheelchair. There is a ground floor bedroom and a shower room with wheel-in shower, handrails and space for side transfer to WC. It has 3 further bedrooms upstairs and there are accessible paths to most lakes.

East Rose Farm is situated near Bodmin in Cornwall and has two accessible cottages. Mowhay was originally a granite farm outbuilding that has been sympathetically converted into a well-appointed cottage. The cottage has one double bedroom with substantial shower room suitable for wheelchair users, one twin bedroom, a bathroom, an open plan kitchen and lounge and dining area in the traditional Cornish Roundhouse. Shippen Cottage was originally a farm outbuilding that has been converted into a well-appointed cottage. There is one double bedroom, a substantial shower room suitable for wheelchair users and an open plan kitchen and lounge.

Island Lake has access to two pegs especially provided for the disabled angler and is stocked with Roach, Rudd and Bream to 3lb, and Crucian Carp to 4lb.

11)* The Tynycornel Hotel is approximately 10 miles north of Machynlleth on the B4405 at Tal-y-llyn. The Hotel is situated in beautiful countryside beside the Talyllyn Lake in the Snowdonia National Park. There is excellent access to the restaurant, lounge and bar. One of the hotels bedrooms (Teal) has been purpose built for wheelchair users and has easy access from the hotel along a covered level pathway. The twin bedded room has good internal dimensions and a spacious en-suite wetroom with room to right hand side transfer to the toilet. The Hotel owns the lake and guests can make use of one of the two accessible wheely boats if they wish to fish it (It is one of the few remaining natural brown trout fisheries south of Scotland).

It is twin bedded self catering accommodation with a compact en-suite shower/bathroom. The shower has a fixed seat and a tray that is set an inch below floor level and at present side transfer to the WC would be difficult because of the pedestal basin. There is communal access to a barbecue area, a games room with pool table on site and to a trout pool in the grounds. Well behaved pets are welcome.
