This list has been compiled as a result of many requests for information for fully accessible holiday accommodation.

Unlike the majority of our literature we have not visited all the places included. Those with an asterisk * we have visited and whilst we have tried to ensure the information is correct, we strongly urge you to consult with the owners of each property about the appropriateness of the accommodation for your own specific needs.

Hotels

The Ramada Plaza Hotel is situated on the Western edge of Wrexham and is only 1 mile from the town centre. It has four accessible rooms (3 non smoking and 1 smoking) all with en-suite wet rooms. There is plenty of designated parking and level access to reception and around the ground floor bar, lounge and dining areas. (N.B. The designated accessible toilet off of the lounge area has no side transfer and no turning space). There are no ground floor bedrooms in the hotel and the accessible rooms are situated on the first and second floors (accessed via a lift).

All guests have use of the sauna and spa (with hoist and a wheeled shower chair).

The Wild Pheasant is situated just off the A5 (Corwen Road) on the outskirts of Llangollen approximately 12 miles from Wrexham. The hotel has one wheelchair accessible suite on the first floor. There is designated parking and level access to reception and around the ground floor restaurant, lounge and bar areas. There is also a good accessible toilet off of the lounge.

Guests have use of the pool area and steam room and sauna (N.B. Wheelchair users will need to be able to transfer in the sauna and there is no hoist for the pool however there is access to a changing room and the shower). There is also wheelchair access to the landscaped grounds.

Approximately 10 miles north of Machynlleth on the B4405 at Tal-y-llyn is the Tynycornel Hotel. The Hotel is situated in beautiful countryside beside the Talyllyn Lake in the Snowdonia National Park. There is excellent access to the restaurant, lounge and bar. One of the hotels bedrooms (Teal) has been purpose built for wheelchair users and has easy access from the hotel along a covered level pathway.

The hotel owns the lake and guests can make use of one of the two accessible wheely boats if they wish to fish it (N.B. It is one of the few remaining natural brown trout fisheries south of Scotland).

The hotel is owned by the charity Livability (formerly John Grooms) and was designed specifically for people with disabilities. As well as the double and twin bedded rooms it also has 6 single rooms with en suite wheel-in shower rooms and 1 single with bathroom en-suite.

Dee Valley Cottages are situated approximately 19 miles west of Wrexham and 2.5 miles from Llangollen adjacent to the A5. They are set on the slopes of the picturesque Dee Valley overlooking the surrounding countryside and would make an ideal base for exploring this part of North Wales. Snowdonia, Chester, Shrewsbury and Liverpool are also all within an easy days drive.

Swallows has a ground floor twin/single bedroom and an adjacent shower room with a level access shower, upstairs is a further bedroom which could be suitable for family members or a carer/carers. The owners have made a great deal of effort to ensure the cottage is both accessible and a pleasant and comfortable holiday experience. There is level access throughout the ground floor of the cottage including the decked patio with its stunning views of the valley through which the Llangollen heritage railway also runs.

Bryn Halen Mawr is set in peaceful countryside near the small village of Melin-y-wig (five miles from Corwen and approximately 22 miles west of Wrexham) . The Shippon has been sympathetically converted to provide accessible self catering accommodation.

Also on site is a beautiful 18th century four bed roomed cottage (sleeping up to 8 people) and wheelchair users can access the ground floor of this. So this might be suitable for larger families and groups with one wheelchair member. It may be possible to provide extra care assistance morning and evenings as well as mobility aids and portable hoist hire with prior arrangement. Friday change overs have recently been introduced to enable a longer season of weekend bookings in addition to weekly hire.

Pentre Bach Holiday Cottages are situated on the A493 approximately 12 miles west of Tal-y-llyn. One of the cottages called Pen-y-lon has wheelchair access and a ground floor double bedroom (right or left hand transfer). The cottage has a conservatory with uninterrupted views to the sea and wheelchair access to the garden. Upstairs are two further bedrooms, one double and one triple plus a separate bathroom. There is a ground floor bathroom with a level access shower.

The mainline railway station is approximately 600 yds away and is wheelchair accessible.

The ground floor bedroom has a double bed with right or left hand transfer and sufficient underneath clearance for a portable hoist. There is also a door out on to the rear patio with views over the surrounding peaceful woodland. Well behaved pets are welcome.
